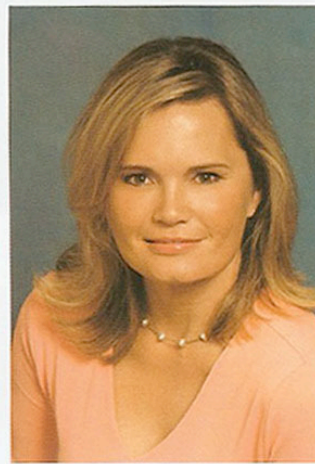
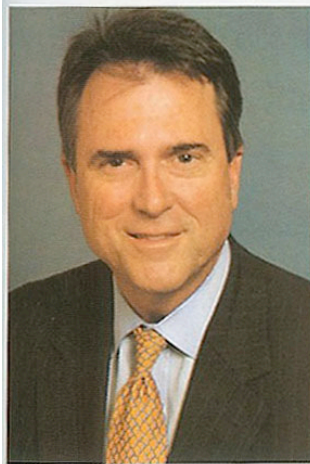


## How I Spend My *Summer Vacation*
